

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

There are two major sections which are provided in this chapter, namely conclusions and suggestions. In conclusions, the author concludes the data analysis of this study. In the suggestions, the author gives some suggestion to the teacher, the reader, and to the other researcher.

5.1. Conclusions

According to the data analysis and the discussion in the previous chapter, the author would like to convey the conclusions of this paper as follows:

In this part, the researchers use theory from Quirk and Green Baum (1973) to analyze the forms and functions of prepositional phrases. Researchers found prepositional phrases in the short story Eleonora. The final result, the function of prepositional phrases was found 70 forms and 70 as functions, in the text, there are 31 forms as adjective (44.3%) and 39 functions as a adverb (50.55%). Most of the function of prepositional phrases is to forms as adverb. for function there are 29 function as adjunct (41%) , there are 7 function as conjunct (10%), there are 4 function as disjunct (5,7%), there are 2 function as post modifier a noun (2,8%), there are 16 function as complementation of a verb (23%) and there are 12 function as complementation of an adjective (17%). Most of the function of prepositional phrases is to forms as adjunct.

The adverb phrase is used to explain the verb or verbs in the sentence . This phrase consists of information about time and information about place, adverbs often appear in Eleonora's short stories because the short story explains a lot about a location in the story so that the adverbial form often appears and the function that often appears in Eleonora's short story is adjunct because the adjunct provides information about the place and explains the time in Eleonora's short story.

5.2. Suggestions

At the end of the research, the author would like to give some suggestions based on the conclusions, as follow:

1. For the teacher

The teacher can use this paper to add their teaching materials especially about phrases.

2. For the reader

This study can be useful to enrich the knowledge and comprehension about phrases and their types by reading and understanding many phrases. Mastering phrases would help to add the vocabularies and the language variation.

3. For the other researchers

This study is based on the analysis of the phrases especially in types and the patterns. Therefore, this study can be useful as a reference to analyze the other research dealing with the phrases materials.
